Janmasthanmi the birthday of Lord Krishna is celebrated with great devotion and enthusiasms. In India in the Hindu calendar this religious festival is celebrated on the Asthmi of Krishna Paksh on the 8th day of the dark fort night in the month of Bhadon.

Sri Krishna is considered as one of the most powerful human incarnations of Lord Vishnu. He was born around 5200 years ago in Mathura. The soul objective of Sri Krishna's birth was to free the earth from the evilness of the demons.
